The meeting began at 7:00 PM.

EASTER EGG HUNT:

Mr. Cain said that the Easter Egg Hunt went well. They had about 150 children.

SUMMER RECREATION:

Mr. Cain said that he is working with the N.Y.S. Department of Health on a safety plan that has been on going for two years. Mr. Cain said that the summer program needs to comply with all the regulations to receive their certificate of health.

Mr. Cain said that they would need to fill positions for the four parks. Interviews will be held on May 11, 2010 starting at 5:30 at Mertensia Park. Mr. Cain said that they would need to hire 3 park leaders, 6 assistance leaders and 4 counselors in training (c.i.t.'s). Mr. Cain will place an ad in the Daily Messenger newspaper about available positions.

Mr. Cain said that he is again working with the Ontario County Work Force Development program. Last year they were able to hire two employees and would like to hire four this year. The county is waiting to see if they get funding from the State. Mr. Cain said that the application were done and were sent this week.

Mr. Cain said that he has started to look at scheduling field trips. He is working on scheduling Rock Venture, Red Wings Baseball, Seabreeze, and bowling. The tots will go to Long Acres Farms.

Mr. Cain will place an ad in the Penny Saver and Farmbrook newsletter with the dates of registration. Registration will be held at the Town Hall on May 17 & 19 for Farmington residents only, and May 24 & 26 will be open to the public. The Recreation members agreed to allow 200 children to register at Mertensia Park and 150 children at Farmbrook Park, Town Park, and Pumpkin Hook Park.

The Clerk of the Boards will send out vendor letters. A letter to the Town Board members will be sent asking them to contact the Sheriff's Department, Fire Department, and Mr. Royal Purdy asking for use of his land.

The Clerk of the Board will send a memo to Mr. McLaughlin asking him to rent porta potties for the celebration.

Mr. Cain said that the contract has been signed for the fireworks and Paulsen, Baker, and Garvey have agreed to play again this year.

NEW PROGRAM:

Mr. Cain told all members to check out the town web site. There is a new program starting called Zumba (dancing with aerobics) starting on May 5, 2010 with Colleen Avery. There is a \$5.00 walk in fee.
