



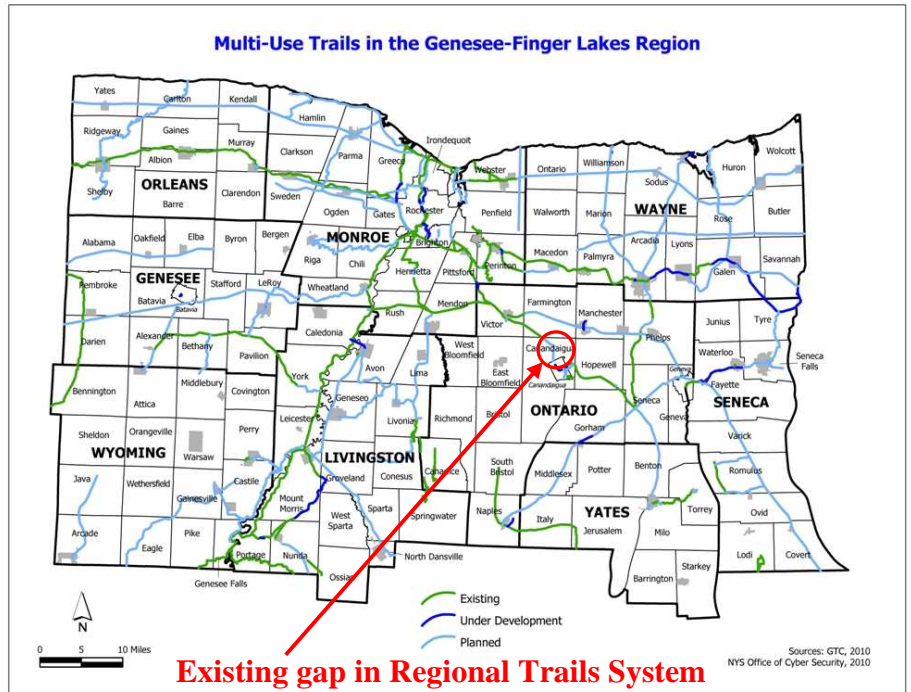
Auburn Trail Connection to Ontario Pathways Trail

The residents of the City of Canandaigua, Town of Canandaigua and the Town of Farmington have expressed the need to connect segments of existing trails in all three municipalities to existing regional and state-wide trail systems - through surveys and documentation in the various Parks and Recreation Master Plans and Comprehensive Plans. In response to this identified need, the three municipalities have secured funding to perform a study to evaluate the feasibility of constructing a multi-use trail connecting to the Auburn Trail in the Towns of Victor and Farmington and Ontario Pathways Trail in the City of Canandaigua.
