

## CONSERVATION BOARD FEBRUARY 28, 2011

### MINUTES:

Mr. Hall made a motion to approve the January 24, 2011 minutes, seconded by Mr. Baldwin. All present members voted “aye” to approve.

### WORKSHOP:

Mr. Kasper said that a workshop is being held on Tuesday, March 22, 2011 on the Emerald Ash Borer, at the Genessee County Building, Batavia, NY.

### PLANNING BOARD APPLICATIONS:

The Conservation members reviewed the following Planning Board applications.

A. Badger Technologies, County Road 41. A 13,000 sq. ft. building expansion.. The members reviewed and discussed the plans. The dumpsters will be relocated to an existing wall where they will be screened and have better protection from the weather.

Preliminary approval had eleven conditions before going to Final approval. The Conservation members had the following comments.

1. They are asking about the (swppp) sewer/water pollution prevention plan. It looks like they are disturbing an area greater than an acre.
2. They would like to see a landscaping plan.
3. They are asking how does the new parking lot drain.

B. Comprehensive Plan Maps.

After a lengthy discussion the Conservation Board feels that direct input from the land owner is needed. If the owner does not object to identifying the parcel as single family

residents (yellow) then the board does not object to identifying them as such. If in the case the owner wishes them to remain identified as agriculture the Comprehensive Plan Update should look to identify other agriculture parcels within the southwest quadrant of town for residential growth.

Ms. Hilton made a motion to adjourned the meeting at 9:15 PM, seconded by Mr. Murphy. All members voted to adjourn.
