Ms. Neale said that she spoke to Mr. Floyd Kofahl, Code Enforcement Officer concerning fencing. Mr. Kofahl said that the Town of Farmington has no legal responsibility for fencing around any cemeteries, this would be either a State or Federal matter. Mr. Kofahl will continue to research.

The current developer of the former Hathaway property has said that he would be responsible to see that the cemetery is protected when development begins. This property is in the process of being developed for senior housing.

HOUSE TOUR:

Ms. Neale and Ms. Hartsough discussed the suggestion of having a tour of historical homes in Farmington. The members recommend a drive by tour. If there is to be a tour of the inside of homes, the historic preservation members will help out in a minimal way.
