PLAQUE:

Ms. Hartsough said that she spoke with Mr. Irving French and the Farmington Grange would be pleased to have a plaque. The Grange was built for the Wesleyan Methodist Church around 1848-1850. The building is now owned by the Grange.

CEMETERIES:

Ms. Neale brought a copy of the Town Code, Section 16.1302, Cemetery Preservation Advisory Board. She also spoke to Mr. Fafinski, Town Supervisor about the cemeteries in town.

Each member is to read over the town code and be ready to discuss at the June meeting. An assessment of each cemetery's condition will need to be done.

Ms. Neale spoke to Mr. Floyd Kofahl, Farmington Code Enforcement Officer about Hathaway Cemetery. The current owner, Mr. John Walch is aware that the cemetery is protected. There is no development being done at this time.

FARMINGTON HISTORICAL SOCIETY:

Ms. Burson shared information on a Farmington Historical Society meeting that she attended.

Ms. Burson said that she is looking at hosting a house tour of homes more than 100 yr. old. The members discussed the liability of doing a house tour where the public would be able to go inside the homes, or just doing a drive by tour. Ms. Neale will ask the Town Supervisor if the Farmington Historical Commission is allowed charge money or ask for donations.
