Mr. Cain welcomed everyone to the meeting and introductions were made.

**MINUTES:**

**JULY 3 CELEBRATION:**

Mr. Cain said that he has heard from the following vendors. Posella’s Pizza, Farmington Chamber of Commerce, Boy Scouts, and Victor cheerleaders.

**SUMMER RECREATION:**

Mr. Cain said that on June 17, 2010 he would meet with the Department of Health. They will review every park and do a walk through. The Department of Health will make any recommendation of things that will need to be done. Mr. Cain said that he would give every member a copy of the plan he has been working on with the Health Inspector.

Mertensia Park will have a 20 x 40 foot tent that will be used for the program. The Town Board members do not want the summer recreation children running around inside the lodge.

Mr. Cain said that the zumba classes being held on Wednesday nights are going well. The instructor may decide to hold a class on another night as well.

Mr. Cain said that he got a call from a martial arts instructor who would like to speak with him about holding a class for the children. Mr. Cain will meet with him and make sure that he is a licensed, certified instructor.

Mr. Cain said that they would be pairing up with Canandaigua golf team for youth golf lessons. The cost will be \$30.00 for 3 lessons at Centerpoint Golf Course.

**FALL PROGRAMS:**
