1. Noise affecting nearby residents
2. Proximity to wetlands-may fall within 100 feet buffer
3. The Department of Conservation may need to be notified, environmental long form maybe necessary.
4. Migratory birds
5. Flight path over a county route

B. 30 x 108 foot green house (to be used for agriculture only)
