Mr. Kasper welcomed and introduced Mr. Pat Murphy, newest member to the Conservation Board.

MINUTES:

Ms. Hilton made a motion to approve the May 24, 2010 minutes, seconded by Mr. Kasper. All members voted "aye" to approve.

TOWN BOARD:

Mr. Kasper read a resolution adopted by the Farmington Town Board on January 26, 2010. This resolution authorizes the board to seek a grant application for the preparation of a Town of Farmington Agricultural and Farmland Protection Plan.

BLUEWAY PROJECT:

Mr. Kasper reviewed a memo to the Town of Farmington from the Genesee-Finger Lakes Regional Planning Council. They have been working on a project know as the Genesee-Finger Lakes Regional Blueway Analysis. They have been looking at "blueways" small boat and paddling routes that combine recreation and environmental awareness and allow users to travel to designated stops along the way for rest, overnight stays, and enjoyment of land-based attraction in the vicinity.

The Genesee-Finger Lakes Regional Planning Council have identified, described and ranked lake, canal and riparian corridors throughout the nine-county Genesee-Fingerlakes region based upon their suitability for blueway use and designation.

QUAKER MEETING HOUSE PLAN:

The members reviewed the plans for the Quaker Meeting House. This will be done over six years and they will need to obtain a Special Use Permit.

ADOPT-A-HIGHWAY:

All members should clean their portion of Mertensia Road.
