

Summer Camp Rules and Guidelines

CHECK YOUR CALENDAR & SCHEDULES DAILY

Check the “daily activity” schedule, it will list the scheduled field trips and planned activities. Please remember that **times and activities may vary** due to weather (i.e., rain on swim day).

TBK closes at 6:00 p.m. In the event a parent arrives after 6:00 p.m. to pick up his/her camper it is necessary to impose an additional fee of \$1.00 per minute for every minute past 6:00 p.m. **ALL LATE FEES must be paid at the time of pick-up.**

FIELD TRIPS

We will depart at different times depending on the field trip for that day. If your child is not here when we leave campus, they will be placed in another class. **NO REFUNDS PROVIDED FOR MISSED FIELD TRIPS**

1. **Some field trips include lunch.** Check the daily activity schedule
2. Parents are welcome to attend any field trip or event at their own expense.
(One days advance notice must be given.)
3. Children may bring up to \$10 spending money for the arcade on Skating; US Play; Bowling; etc. TBK is not responsible for any lost money. Children are required to keep up with their own money.

DAILY SCHEDULE

Preschool-1st grade children will need to have a towel or a blanket for nap/ quiet time.
2nd-6th grade will have a tutoring during “quiet” time.

DAILY DRESS CODE

Campers should be dressed appropriately in play clothes, with the understanding that clothing may get dirty.

1. T-shirts and **modest** shorts are the best choice of clothing for our planned activities.
2. All shorts worn must be in good taste. Shorts with holes in them are **unacceptable**.
3. All shirts need to cover the midriff on boys and girls.
4. **Tennis shoes and socks** need to be worn every day.
5. **Sandals are not acceptable** due to the various activities the camper may be engaged in.

On swim days, campers may bring swim shoes to wear at the pool.

6. On swim days, **girls** must have a modest, **one-piece or tankini/shorts swimsuit** (two-piece bikini suits are not permitted). Girls must wear shirt and shorts over their swim suits at all times; except when at the pool.
7. **Boys** need to wear a shirt with their swim trunks
8. **Campers will need a towel and sun screen daily. Please label everything with the camper’s name, food, clothing, etc.**

9. All campers should keep one full change of clothes with them. There are times we get wet and need to change.

SWIMMING INFORMATION

4-6yrs need to bring their swimsuits daily in their book bag. Group 4-6 yrs will be going on to Sewell Mill Park Pool in Marietta. This facility has lifeguards on duty and has two separate pools, one for those that can swim and one for wading in the water.

EACH CHILD WILL BE TESTED TO SEE SWIMMING ABILITY

The older campers will also go to Sewell Mill Park & Dellinger Park Pool in Cartersville, weather permitting. TBK may have water days; TBD. Your child may bring or wear their swimsuits on these days. Dellinger Park Pool also has lifeguard onsite. Please bring the following:

1. Sunscreen
2. Towel & swim shoes
3. Bag to store all belongings
4. Plastic bag for wet clothes
5. A COMPLETE change of clothes
6. Bring a water soaker no larger than half the camper's size if applicable

FOOD

1. TBK will provide a morning and afternoon snacks, and drinks throughout the day.
2. **LUNCH IS NOT PROVIDED: Camper is responsible for his/her own lunch. All sack lunches should be in disposable containers and bags; AND does not require a microwave or refrigeration.**
3. **FRIDAY – PIZZA DAY** – TBK will provide pizza for campers. Campers that are scheduled for a field trip that day will need to bring a sack lunch.
4. **A sack lunch must be provided for campers who do not want or are unable to eat pizza on Fridays.**

CAMPERS NEED TO BRING TO SUMMER CAMP DAILY?

1. Water bottle *daily!*
2. *Disposable* lunch and snack
3. Book bag to hold belonging
4. Book to read

(Please label all items of clothing, water bottles, etc.)

WHAT SHOULD BE LEFT AT HOME?

1. All electronics (cell phone, iPods, hand held games, etc)
2. Toys, etc.
3. Money: (The only time they will be permitted to bring money is on appropriate field trip days.)
